

The recertification is intended to be a verification of your knowledge, skills and facilitating experience. Recertification candidates will be required to present a completed Challenge Course Experience Portfolio, pass a practical skills test, and pass a written test. Please be sure to review your Challenge Course/ Climbing Wall knowledge and practice your skills *before* the recertification.

### **What to Expect at the Recertification:**

- 1.) **Portfolio Review**-- In order to recertify you must present the trainer with a portfolio of RCC program delivery experience. This document will be reviewed, verified and returned to you. Please see the link on our website for a sample portfolio template.
- 2.) **Practical Skills Test**—This part of the recertification will focus on knot tying, belaying, high event set-ups, spotting, lead climbing/lobster clawing, and any other skills specific to your site. You will be expected to display confidence and solid competency in these skills.
- 3.) **Written Test**—This will be in the form of a 20 true/false question test. A score of 80% must be achieved to pass. This test will be proctored and evaluated on site.

### **Your Portfolio: Requirements**

All individuals recertifying in 2010 **must** meet these minimum portfolio requirements:

- Provide a Challenge Course Experience Portfolio documenting **50 hours of program delivery experience, and applicable trainings/workshops in the previous year.**

### **How long will the Recertification take?**

All of our clients have different needs and different facilities which creates a lot of variables in determining how long the recertification will take. It is safe to say that the recertification will take longer than in years past. How long depends on the preparation and skill level of the staff being recertified. To help expedite the process, please have portfolios completed and ready for verification and practice all applicable practical skills.
